Month 1

1. Up-tempo Sax - All The Mystery - Sax solo energetic
2. Slow - Smokey Cafe - Jazzy piano trio light hearted theme
3. Techno - Confusion - Modern Techno Hip Hop
4. Slow - Don't Give Up - Thoughtful, reflective feel with positive resolution
5. Piano Solo - Ken's Theme - Solo Piano, uplifting, positive and light melody

Month 2

1. Fast - Booker Does It - Memphis soul organ rock theme in a minor key
2. Inspirational - Dawn of Man - Orchestra build to huge climax
3. Piano Solo - Reflections - Light piano solo, soft and natural sounding
4. Up-tempo Sax - Hipster - Sax solo energy with a little suspense
5. Inspirational - Epic Sunrise - Strings and French horn melody buildup and final resolution

Month 3

1. Piano Solo - Fur Elise - Beethoven classic slow and melancholy theme, public domain
2. Up-tempo Sax - Latino Sax - energetic melody with sax background section, feels like a salsa
3. Inspirational - Inspiration - Synthe melody over building modern piano rhythm section

4. Medium tempo - Moving Along Trot - Acoustic guitar driving rhythm, with moving keyboard melodies

5. Techno - Trance Pulse - Driving bass and techno house feel, modernistic

Month 4

1. Medium - Law Atlanta – Funky wah guitar lead, rock TV like theme. Medium tempo, energy and fun.

2. Slow - Bonnie Girl – Slower melancholy theme with echoed guitar melody. Thought provoking, soft and reflective feeling. String pads as well

3. Fast - Heavy Driving Force – Driving grunge rock, guitar hero game music, chase scenes, sports, and energy

4. Medium - Philadelphia Hero – 70's feeling, wah wah guitar and brass lead. Heroic, triumph, and feeling of winners

5. Slow- Sad Day – Solo piano in minor key. Serious and sad feelings or subjects

Month 5

1. Medium - Say What? Flute melody, light but rhythmic and drive, key board pushes

2. Fast - Slamming Dude - Driving beat with 80's synthe lead and piano fills

3. Medium - Techno - Split Up Da Funk - Mysterious backgrounds and sounds, with driving minor bass line

4. Techo - Power Guitar - Too Dark To See - Guitar power chords over driving techno house beat

5. Serious, Sad and Energy - What You Don't Know - String minor key build up to percussion pulse to crescendo finish. Like a movie trailer theme

Month 6

1. Jim's Crescendo - High energy -driving fast beat with accents to an ever building finish.
2. Life Flow - Slow - Soft Flowing arpeggios with flute melody, natural and outdoor sounding.
3. Lindsey's Thailand - World - Pan flute melody over a lone end drone. Feels like being in the Far East.
4. Stevie Funk - Rock - Energetic clavinet rock like a late night TV theme, 70's classic feel
5. Solemn Refrain - Medium -serious and sad felling with driving minor key beat, high end keyboard accents

Month 7

1. Hurry Up - Energy - fast moving walking bass line that ever pounds like you are in a hurry. Light electric piano stabs for accent
2. Late Night - Fast - Synthe sounds with driving energy, could be used for a news theme or late night talk show, podcast
3. Light Heart - Medium - Acoustic light hearted feel, works with outdoor scenery and big open spaces, string melody
4. Out There - Medium - New age voices, tribal rhythms, house bass line, female mystery melody
5. Regal Sincere - Slow - Majestic string pads with woodwind melodies, French horn support, could be a march of royalty

Month 8

1. Silent Movie - Old timey piano theme that is perfect for history video and subjects referring to the past.
2. Am Be Ant - Techno theme with a mystery ambience feel, very electronic and ethereal sounds
3. Twelve String Strum - A little bit of a rocker with lots of acoustic guitars strumming just for support, no melody to get in way of narration
4. Rainbow 8 To The Bar - 50's rock with hot guitar lead and horn section support. You will think the King is coming on stage, Thank You Very Much!
5. Aw Nuts, Kids - Piano and bass in up-tempo melody that makes you think of those kids who say, Good Grief!

Month 9

1. Colors - Slow minor key to major resolution key orchestration of cello and violins with a flute melody, dirge like with happy ending, Piano rhythm
2. Just an Illusion - Mystery choral ahhs with funky guitar licks, minor key with energy and hip hop low end bass riffs
3. Newage Mike- Drone and floating feel with effects of echoed sounds and wind chimes.
4. Smoking Land Breeze - Driving updated 70's sounding R & B band with guitar solos and bottom end. Medium tempo
5. Down Right All Right - Medium tempo positive driving theme, popping bass and string pads, great for voice over and uplifting subjects

Month 10

1. The Fifties – Sax solo, slow standard ballad like Fats Domino or Platters would have sung to
2. The Sixties – Fast, Rock and roll track with a flair from the British invasion, even used my Hofner bass on this one
3. The Seventies - Disco Sax solo, funky with clavinet rhythm, you can see the leisure suits and mirror balls
4. The Eighties – Driving rock with synthe theme, power chords and fast energy
5. The Nineties – Medium tempo hip hop drums and mysterious melody or house bass line

Month 11

1. Poppy – Electronic pops, hip hop drum track, computer and high tech theme
2. Laid Back Sad – Minor slow acoustic guitar, with electric piano motifs, like an old sad song
3. Hit the Can - Driving medium tempo percussive theme with mystery sound effects
4. Very Serious – Mysterious, serious suspenseful theme with cellos, ominous brass
5. Looking Back On Life – Slow inspirational piano and string them :60 and 2:30 long theme bonus

Month 12 - Acoustic Unplugged Month!

1. Unplugged Guitar - soft, slow lilting guitar finger picking melody and arpeggios
2. Unplugged Piano - soft, flowing solo piano melody, light hearted and reflective
3. Unplugged Ballad - slow piano melody ballad with guitar and acoustic bass guitar
4. Unplugged Medium - light but upper tempo piano melody with rhythm acoustic and acoustic bass guitar
5. Unplugged Train - Train brushes rhythm with piano accents and acoustic lead guitar melody, moving down the path music.
